**February 7, 2011 Keith Short of Seaford. He is a serious collector of railroadiana otherwise known as railroad memorabilia.)**

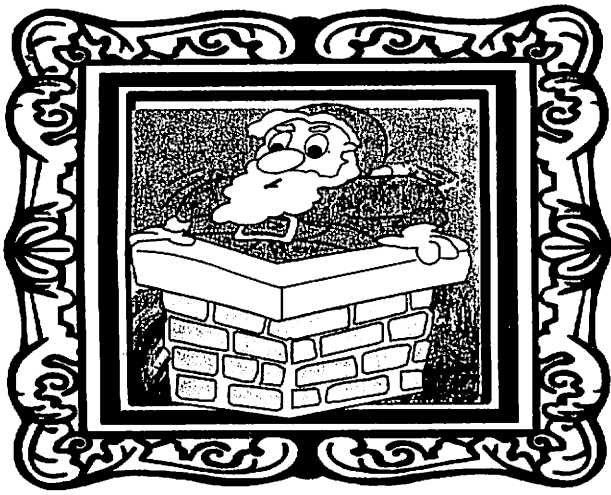
**March 7, 2011 Mike Lambert author of the book "Eastern Shore League." He will speak on this subject of years past. The book is on sale at our gift shop.**

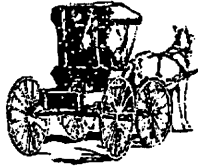

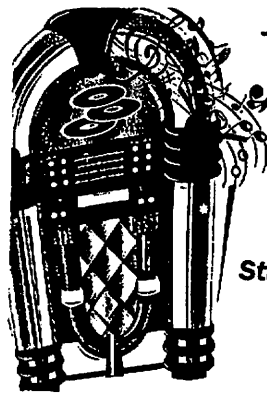
